

Canlan Scarborough Arena Guidelines

Please note that all contracts are subject to the rules and regulations of the Ontario Government during this pandemic, and therefore, may change at any time.

Due to the Covid Pandemic, our overall ice allocation and availability at our Scarborough location has changed significantly compared with last year. Based on availability, returning contract holders will be given priority over new customers to renew their respective ice contracts. Ice time will be offered in queue based on application submission date. If we are unable to offer returning contract holders comparable ice times on the same day/time that they had for the 2019/20 season, we hope to help them arrange a suitable contract on another day/time, or perhaps at another Canlan facility. These contracts are FALL ONLY contracts.

Currently we are basing these contracts on Phase 3 of Ontario's re-opening, and at the time of this application the following rules/restrictions will apply to FALL ONLY 2020 contracts:

- 1) Contracts will be 12 – 13 weeks long starting September 28, 2020 and running until December 31, 2020.
- 2) Contracts are in multiple of 50 minutes in length
 - 60 min – 10 min for ice resurfacing,
 - No 90 min contracts
- 3) Ice rental capacity will be 24 (including all coaches/players).
- 4) There will be no spectators for ice rentals.
- 5) Dressing rooms are not guaranteed and are dependent on availability.
- 6) There will be no showering on premises.
- 7) Water fountains will be unavailable.
- 8) A mask must be worn—with the sole exception of when on ice.
- 9) Expectoration (spitting) is strictly prohibited at all times.
- 10) Under no circumstances will there be any sort of player–to-player contact.
- 11) The contract holder will have to get agreement from all participants that they will adhere to the rules and guidelines we have established,
- 12) The contract holder will have implemented measures to keep participants and others at least 2 metres apart, wherever possible, including off-ice warm-up, expedient arrival and departure, arriving in gear, etc.,
- 13) The contract holder will have created and communicated to participants, coaches, and support volunteers our safety plan that adheres to physical distancing, and have confirmed that they agree as outlined,
- 14) The contract holder must notify the Facility of any COVID-19 symptoms or diagnosis up to 14 days after every ice time.
