



Paramount Ice has developed protocols in conjunction with provincial regulations in order to keep our customers and staff safe during our COVID re-opening process.

Please read the following protocols before entering the facility. Thank you!

- The maximum number of people allowed on the following ice surfaces are as follows; (Rink 1 NHL Size) = 25 people/ (Rink 2) = 15 max/ (Rink 3) = 10 max
- There will be access to the dressing rooms starting September 1st 2020. Our staff will be responsible for spraying and cleaning all dressing rooms after use.
- Participants will be granted entry to the rink a maximum of 30 minutes before their scheduled ice time and must exit the building promptly after the rental up to a max of 20 mins. This allows us to take the proper measures cleaning the facility for the following rentals.
- There is one main entrance to the building, all exit doors are separate and clearly marked. No person shall exit through the entrance doors.
- There will be 1 spectator allowed in the facility per child.
- All whom enter the facility must wear a face mask. Players/ skaters may take the mask off when they enter onto the ice but must put the mask back on when their session is finished.
- All participants or parents/ guardians must have signed our digital liability waiver before entering the facility.
- Physical distancing must always be maintained in the facility. When on ice we will be following the guidelines and protocols set forth by the governing bodies of the OHF/Hockey Canada.
- Access to the washrooms are now permitted, sanitising stations are throughout the facility and encouraged.
- The office will not be open for public inquiry, if you have an immediate concern, we ask that you call our office line and someone will assist you (416-551-5306).
- Finally, we ask that if you see something that is a cause for concern in relation to the persons not following the COVID guidelines set above to please notify us immediately.
