

The Factory Vic Park

During current guidelines from the Ontario Government, we have developed our protocols to ensure that you, your family and our staff are kept safe.

Importantly, as per the municipal and provincial bylaws, masks are mandatory for everyone when in the building. Participants and instructors may remove masks when they leave their dressing areas with the intent to enter the ice.

Hand sanitizing or glove wearing is also mandatory for all people entering the facility.

We ask that, if possible, participants come to the rink as close to fully dressed as possible. We will provide designated changing areas to complete dressing and tie skates. Parents or guardians will not be allowed in the dressing rooms, if skates need to be tied, help can be provided in the hallway.

ENTERING THE FACILITY

Please arrive at the facility 15 minutes before your ice time. Upon entering the building, each participant and their guardian will enter the lobby of the rink, one family at a time, and proceed to the registration desk. If a family is already in the rink lobby, other families will be required to line up, keeping social distancing, outside in the main lobby.

REGISTRATION

If this is the participants first time at The Factory, both the Communicable Disease and Participation waivers must be filled out and dropped off before entrance to either rink will be permitted. These waivers are attached. If you have any issues, please let us know.

In addition, a Health Risk Assessment must be filled out for **each daily visit** into The Factory for **every person** entering the rink (including all participants, guardians and workers).

ENTERING THE RINK

Once registered, the participant and their guardian will be assigned a dressing room or area, social distancing is mandatory and each room can accommodate up to 8 people while maintaining proper distances. If you have more than 8 participants per room assigned, then we ask that you dress in waves. If guardians do not need to assist their participants, they may proceed to the stands where they need to socially distance and wear masks .

ENTERING THE ICE

At time to enter the ice, participants can line up as a group and enter onto the ice. We do ask that participants practice social distancing on and off the ice as much as possible.

VIEWING

One guardian per participant will be allowed to enter the buildings. Each one entering must have completed the High Risk Assessment document and must wear a mask and socially distance from other viewers at 6 feet or more.

EXITING THE ICE

When the session is complete, participants will have 10 minutes to undress. Participants will exit the arena via posted exits to the main lobby of the building and meet with their guardian.
