

For Baycrest additional Protocols

As well as following all the City of Toronto Covid Guidelines and filling out your Covid questionnaire additional protocols at Baycrest Arena include:

Entrance to the building is at the front of the Building facing the parking lot.

Exiting the building is through the doors on the east (by dressing room #4)

All people entering the building should have completed and passed a Covid questionnaire and have a mask on

Change rooms are unavailable but have very minimal capacity allowances and players are to wait patiently and socially distanced if they are at capacity until others exit the room. Capacity signs are on each dressing room door

Players are to arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to their set ice time, they are to be fully dressed with the exception of skates, helmet and gloves. They should only have a small dufflet bag for equipment. An exception is made for goalies.

If a player does need parent assistance they will be asked to leave immediately after they have assisted their player, through the east end exits by dressing room #4. This person must also fill out a Covid questionnaire and wear a mask.

Once ready, stand at/near the arena glass to the left of the ice surface door, make sure to maintain social distancing space and wait for the other team to exits and the ice to be resurfaced

The team benches will be marked with tape

No spectators to be allowed in the arena

Parent can pick up their players at the east exit doors of the building

Players should exit through the doors in the corner of rink 2
