

LEASIDE GARDENS COVID-19 PROTOCOLS.

Entering and Exiting the Facility

Please enter Leaside Gardens through the main entrance.

Players, coaches, and game officials may enter the facility 30 minutes prior to the start of their session/game. Team safety representatives are encouraged to be visible and present security with a league-sanctioned roster to help expedite the screening process.


Spectators may enter the facility 15 minutes prior to the start of their session/game and are asked to wait until the skaters/player have completed the screening process.


Everyone is asked to leave the facility within 15 minutes of the completion of their session/game.


Capacity Limits:

Current capacity on the ice is limited to 50. Spectators are not permitted in the dressing rooms or the dressing room areas.

Food and drink are not permitted to be brought into the arena while the mask mandate is in place.

	<p>Mandatory Proof of Vaccination</p> <p>In accordance with Ontario Regulation 645/21 under the Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020, S.O. 2020, c. 17 and unless exempted, everyone entering the facility must show proof of complete COVID-19 vaccination (2 doses & 14 days) together with personal identification (including name and birthdate) to enter the facility. Visit Ontario Health to access proof of vaccination.</p>
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	<p>Symptom Screening</p> <p>Visitors will be directed to view to the COVID-19 Active Screening Tool posted at the entrance and asked to respond yes or no to the questions. If the answer is yes to any of the questions, they will not be allowed to enter the facility.</p>
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	<p>Masks and Face Coverings</p> <p>In accordance with the City of Toronto By-Law 541-2020, face masks must be worn in the facility.</p> <p>Masks are not required for skaters on the ice surface but are required for coaches/trainers on the bench and timekeepers.</p> <p>It is particularly important that masks be kept on in the dressing rooms.</p>
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FOR INDIVIDUALS 11 YEARS OF AGE AND UNDER:

When possible, dressing room capacity for individuals 11 years of age and under will be limited to seven (7). Skaters are asked to come fully dressed and use the socially distanced chairs rink-side if the dressing room is full.

Washrooms are open throughout the facility – social distancing measures apply.
